Dates and Times:

April 8th 2013:

10:00 am: Jackson County, 6 miles W of Altus on HWY 62. Turn south, plot on east side of road.

2:00 pm: Kiowa County, From the flashing light at HWY 9 & 44 intersection W of Hobart, go ½ mile south.

5:00 pm: Washita County, From Courthouse in Cordell go 1 m W, 1 m N, then 1 m E. North of road.

April 9th 2013:

10:00 am: Cotton County, From I-44 exit 20, go 2 ½ m W, then 4.75 m S on HWY 277/281. East side of HWY.

3:00 pm: Caddo County, At the OSU Caddo County Research Station near Ft. Cobb. Plot SW of lake dam.

6:30 pm: Canadian County, From I-40 exit 130 (Banner Rd), go ½ m S then 2 ½ m W. North side of road.

April 10th 2013:

10:00 am: Grant County, From HWY 64 & 132 E of Nash, go 4 m S on HWY 132 then ½ m W. North of road.

2:00 pm: Garfield County, At the OSU North Central Research Station 1 m W of Lahoma off HWY 412.

5:00 pm: Noble County, From Perry go about 6 m E on HWY 64, go 1 m N on CR 170 to Knob Hill.

April 11th 2013:

10:00 am: Alfalfa County, On north side of Helena, go 1 m W on 7th St. Plot on south side of road.

12:00 pm: Major County, From Fairview go 2 m S on HWY 58 to Isabella turnoff then 4 m E. North of road.

3:00 pm: Dewey County, From Hill Café in Seiling, go 7 miles east on Indian road.

April 12th 2013:

10:00 am: Ottawa County, From Miami go E to HWY 137 (CR610), go 5 miles north. Plot west side of road.
